TRAVELING

Rail: Train from **Geneva-Airport** to Martigny (approx. 1h45 min.). For timetable details, see the [Swiss federal railways](http://www.sbb.ch), you can also download the mobile app SBB Mobile (available on iOS or Android).

Coming to Martigny by train is the most convenient solution:

- There is a direct connection between the Geneva-Airport station and Martigny station, with a train every 30 minutes.
- The train tickets can be bought at the train station, or via the website <https://www.sbb.ch/en/home.html>.
- There is a possibility to buy cheaper tickets through the website, if Supersaver tickets are available. If you buy a Supersaver ticket, it is only valid for the connection chosen. However if you buy a normal ticket, you can choose whichever connection you prefer.

If you land at **Zurich Airport**, you can take the train to Martigny as well (approx. 2h45 min), with usually 1 or 2 changes depending on the connection chosen.

In Switzerland, trains are the most convenient solution. Although they are expensive, they are also very reliable, mostly on time, there is no need to make reservations in advance and the train stations are located directly in the airports.
